## It's Time for You to Try Autocross with the Cumberland Motor Club

Autocross takes place in a large open paved area. Traffic cones are set up in a series of sweeping and tight turns, straights, chicanes and slaloms...similar to a Formula 1 course. Drivers enter the course one car at a time through a set of timing lights and try to set the best time they can using driving skills and the car's capabilities. Courses are designed with safety in mind and do not exceed normal road speeds. Cars are placed in different classes according to rules set forth by the Sports Car Club of America SOLO II Rules. We also have a kart program for ages 8 and up if you are into karting. And thanks to our new Novice Program, you won't feel totally lost your first time out as we guide you through the experience from registration to driving on the course. Our club strives to provide a friendly atmosphere for everyone to learn about cars, karts and autocross.

**Come on out, give it a try...it's the most fun you'll likely ever have with your car!**

**If you don't want to compete, check it out anyway...it's free to watch or ride along!**

Yes...you can ride with a driver on the course (must be 12 yrs old and sign a waiver). Watching is okay, however, to truly feel the excitement about autocross you need to be in the car...it's a totally different experience being in the passenger seat...and it's FUN!
