**Secretary's Report:**

Motion to accept the last meeting's minutes as published was made, seconded and Approved.

**Treasurer's Report:**

The current balance in the checking account is \$10,852.08. This includes D&O insurance renewal & trophies. Storyland grossed \$2,465.05, Idexx had \$797.84 profit and Stone Cone Killers had \$997.84 profit. The general liability insurance renewal is coming up – about \$1,500.

Motion to accept the Treasurer's report was made, seconded and Approved.

**Rally Report:**

**Slalom Report:**

Overlap presents challenges for timing & scoring. A suggestion made to have cars with multiple drivers only show 1 number at a time or be marked more clearly to avoid confusion at the computer.

The 30 day posting time limit for comments is working well – maybe too well, as club members are noticing mis-classed cars. If the offending driver is a member, we should try to contact them for verification – attempt investigation before changing. For non-members, will make changes based on best knowledge. Need to present a case for changes.

Next event is June 11<sup>th</sup> at the Crooker lot in Bath. Two weeks later is Windham. Will discuss trailer logistics for getting it to Orono at next meeting.
