**Secretary's Report:**

Motion to accept the last meeting's minutes as published was made, seconded and Approved.

**Treasurer's Report:**

Cone Hunting #7 had \$602.05 profit (\$500 for Running Tide benefit – balance \$102.50) and Children of the Cones was \$877.05.

Motion to accept the Treasurer's report was made, seconded and Approved.

**Rally Report:**

Maine Forest Rally is July 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> – moved up a week for X-Games. If you work, you can earn CMC Rally points. Nothing new to report.

Motion to accept Rally report was made, seconded and Approved.

**Slalom Report:**

There have been two events since our last meeting. At Cone Hunting, attendance was down due to threatened weather. There were 68 competitors, 7 runs. For Children of the Cones (still no rain) – there were 78 competitors and 6 runs. Other stats: Storyland Day 1 had 79 competitors, 6 runs; Day 2 had 102 competitors, 5 runs; Neptune's Revenge had 78 competitors, 6 runs; and Stone Cone Killers had 86 competitors, 5 runs. The season average is 81.8 competitors and 5.8 runs.

Coming events: July 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> at UMaine Orono, Wells family is chairing. We are on UMO events calendar. Good news – DJ's dad will tow trailer to UMO & back. Idexx events are up in the air – Chris has been unable to confirm with contact. As contingency, he has spoken to contact at North Windham mall for July 30<sup>th</sup>. Also feels we should take following weekend at Crooker lot as people have expressed interest in having more events. "Secret" location is revealed: Richard Nye's sister works at Unum, spoke to community relations person. Pending safety person's approval, we could do a charity event for the United Way, possibly in September.

Final items - Chris is going ahead with purchase of AX ware. We did order the #3 package with stand for display. The website MyAutoEvent.com has calendar and potential for preregistration. Chris would like to post our remaining events on it.

- Chris had proposed a fall dyno day on the forum. If there is sufficient interest – maybe October? 3 pulls for anyone making changes in tuning. For turbo or superchargers, they will hook up a pressure transducer. Still \$40 for everyone. Chris will book.
- Glen Sutton is chairing Labor Day event. Motion made to have it be a benefit for Coastal Studies for Girls. Slot is available. Motion made, seconded and Approved.
- Dan brought up that we have changed our event processes – we need to document them so that everyone knows what's happening. Changes in tech, registration, etc. are significant. A corner worker protocol would be good, too. Maybe number the buckets. We also need more flags & cones.
