**Secretary's Report:**

Motion to accept the last meeting's minutes as published was made, seconded and Approved.

**Rally Report:**

**Slalom Report:**

In response to questions regarding Kart Pax fairness, Dan presented data comparing Pax for STS & FJ2 to illustrate the point of view that course design determines who has advantage. Based on data presented (see handout), the system we have now is giving reasonable results and there is not an unfair advantage to Karts over cars.

There has been lengthy discussion about adult kart classes with the argument that karts should be “by the book”, like cars. We set up our kart program so that there are parallel classes to enable parents & kids to compete together. SCCA only has F125 for adults. It's difficult to go completely by the book, but our bumping scheme is more fair than SCCA in that it ensures that everyone will be in a group of 3. Rick's kart running will prevent bumping from karts to cars. We have a few options, including changing to F125, leaving as is, or creating a parallel program for adults (no point in that if there are only 2 adults that run a kart as a points vehicle).

Motion made & seconded to modify handbook so that Autocross FSX classes don't bump into car classes & may have only 2 drivers to make a class (section 6.4.2.1). Tabled for vote at next meeting. Chris will make announcement post on forum.
