**Secretary's Report:**

Motion to accept the last meeting's minutes was made, seconded and Approved.

**Treasurer's Report:**

The current balance in the checking account is \$13,231. Deposit from last event has not been entered yet. The Hoosier Daddy event had a \$1,167.00 net profit. **Slalom Report:**

There have been 3 events this month. The July 3<sup>rd</sup> in OOB had 45 participants with 8 runs. July 17th BBR Bash was a major with 80 participants and 5 runs. The 24<sup>th</sup> in Lewiston had 42 participants and 8 runs. Number of runs seems to not to be affected by whether or not it's a "members only", but more by number of people attending. Highlight of the Lewiston event was the CP Camaro, which did well in spite of the tight course. Its drivers thanked Dan for the club's hospitality & plan to attend another event. Regarding event venues, we will most likely not be running at Windham again. Would like to find location around Bangor or Orono, as there have been people coming down from that area in the past. Something north of Augusta would be good. Also considering Fairchild Semiconductor lot.
